SUMMARY—Makes appropriations to University of Nevada, Reno, for expenses of Pediatric Diabetes and Endocrinology Center at School of Medicine, to University of Nevada School of Medicine for its residency program and to Health Division of Department of Human Resources for certain HIV/AIDS services. AN ACT making appropriations to the University of Nevada, Reno, for certain expenses of the Pediatric Diabetes and Endocrinology Center at the School of Medicine, to the University of Nevada School of Medicine for its residency program and to the Health Division of the Department of Human Resources for distribution to the Fighting Aids in Our Community Today (FACT) organization for expenses related to the provision of certain HIV/AIDS services; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
- 2     General Fund to the University of Nevada, Reno, the sum of
- 3     \$44,772 for the operating expenses of the Pediatric Diabetes and
- 4     Endocrinology Center at its School of Medicine during May and
- 5     June of 2003.

1       2. Any balance of the sum appropriated by subsection 1 must  
2 not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to  
3 the State General Fund as soon as all payments of money committed  
4 have been made.

5       **Sec. 2.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
6 General Fund to the Health Division of the Department of Human  
7 Resources the sum of \$250,000 for distribution to Fighting Aids in  
8 Our Community Today (FACT), a Las Vegas organization, for the  
9 provision of community outreach, testing, counseling and  
10 dissemination of information related to HIV/AIDS in the area of  
11 West Las Vegas.

12       2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,  
13 the Fighting Aids in Our Community Today organization agrees to:

14       (a) Use not more than 10 percent of the amount appropriated for  
15 administrative expenses.

16       (b) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance  
17 Committee on or before December 15, 2004, that describes each  
18 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1  
19 from the date on which the money was received by the Organization  
20 through December 1, 2004.

21       (c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available  
22 to the Legislative Auditor any books, accounts, claims, reports,  
23 vouchers, or other records of information, confidential or otherwise  
24 and irrespective of their form or location, that the Legislative  
25 Auditor deems necessary to conduct any audit of the use of the  
26 money appropriated by subsection 1 and distributed to the Fighting  
27 Aids in Our Community Today organization.

28       3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by  
29 subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30,  
30 2005, and reverts to the State General Fund as soon as all payments  
31 of money committed have been made.

32       **Sec. 3.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
33 General Fund to the University of Nevada School of Medicine the  
34 sum of \$250,000 for its residency program.

35       2. Any balance of the sum appropriated by subsection 1 must  
36 not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2005, and reverts to  
37 the State General Fund as soon as all payments of money committed  
38 have been made.

39       **Sec. 4.** 1. This section becomes effective upon passage and  
40 approval.

41       2. Section 1 of this act becomes effective upon passage and  
42 approval and applies retroactively from and after June 30, 2003.

43       3. Sections 2 and 3 of this act become effective upon passage.
