- 1      **Section 1.** Section 1.7 of the Assembly Bill No. 246 of the  
2      74th Session of the Nevada Legislature is hereby repealed.  
3      **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

**TEXT OF REPEALED SECTION**

**Section 1.7 of Assembly Bill No. 246 of the 74th Session of Nevada  
Legislature:**

Sec. 1.7 NRS 3.013 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
3.013 For the Third Judicial District there must be [~~three~~] **two**  
district judges.
