

SENATE BILL NO. 2—COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

JUNE 27, 2008

Referred to Committee of the Whole

SUMMARY—Provides certain flexibility in budgeting for the Department of Health and Human Services. (BDR S-25)

AN ACT relating to state financial administration; authorizing certain sums appropriated to the Department of Health and Human Services to be transferred among the various budget accounts of the Department under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law provides a procedure for the revision of the work program of any
2 department, institution or agency of the Executive Department of the State
3 Government. (NRS 353.220) **Section 1** of this bill authorizes the transfer of certain
4 sums appropriated to the Department of Health and Human Services among the
5 various budget accounts of the Department in the same manner and within the same
6 limits as allowed for revisions of work programs in NRS 353.220.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Section 48 of chapter 350, Statutes of Nevada 2007,
2 at page 1706, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 Sec. 48. **1.** The sums appropriated to the Department
4 of Corrections by section 23 of this act may be transferred
5 among the various budget accounts of the Department of
6 Corrections in the same manner and within the same limits as
7 allowed for revisions of work programs in NRS 353.220.



1 **2. In addition to transfers made pursuant to section 46**
2 **of this act, the sums appropriated to the Department of**
3 **Health and Human Services by section 20 of this act may be**
4 **transferred among the various budget accounts of the**
5 **Department of Health and Human Services in the same**
6 **manner and within the same limits as allowed for revisions**
7 **of work programs in NRS 353.220.**

8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2008.
