The following fiscal impact statements have been submitted in response to the Fiscal Analysis Division's requests for a fiscal note on Assembly Bill 1.

## Nevada System of Higher Education

There is no projected fiscal impact to the Nevada System of Higher Education (NSHE). Any programmatic offerings would be subject to the provisions of Section 4.4 and, if approved, funded through the appropriation already included in this BDR. The consultation and technical assistance provided to the Executive Director of the Office of Economic Development is not quantifiable and part of NSHE's existing workforce mission and funding and therefore not subject to a fiscal note.

## **Department of Education**

There is no projected fiscal impact to the Nevada Department of Education (NDE). The consultation and technical assistance provided to the Executive Director of the Office of Economic Development under Section 7 of the BDR would be within the budget already approved to support the NDE and therefore would not be subject to a fiscal note.

#### Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation

There is no known fiscal impact to the Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation (DETR) at this time. Initial funding for this program is provided through BDR 18-9 from the Office of Science, Innovation, and Technology and the State General Fund.

The Department of Employment, Training, and Rehabilitation will accomplish a commitment to this program through the department's regular course of business. If unforeseen costs should arise, DETR will work with the Governor's Office of Economic Development and apply to the fund.

If the outcomes of this program lead to a significant increase in companies locating to Nevada, DETR will reevaluate current resources to determine whether additional resources are required.
