Assembly Bill No. 1—AN ACT relating to programs for public personnel; temporarily increasing the limitation on the amount of annual leave that certain state employees are authorized to carry forward to the next calendar year; providing for a 1-month suspension during Fiscal Year 2020-2021 of the payment of subsidies by the State to the Public Employees' Benefits Program for group insurance for certain active and retired public officers and employees; requiring state employees to take a certain number of hours of unpaid furlough leave during Fiscal Year 2020-2021; providing exceptions to the furlough requirement; providing that employees who take certain furlough leave are held harmless in the accumulation of service credit and reported salary for retirement under the Public Employees' Retirement System; prohibiting the granting of any merit pay increases to state employees during Fiscal Year 2020-2021; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Assemblywoman Benitez-Thompson moved that the bill be referred to the Committee of the Whole.

Assembly Bill No. 2—AN ACT relating to large school districts; temporarily removing a requirement for the year-end balances of local school precincts in a large school district to be carried forward as a restricted fund balance; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
