1 WHEREAS, An extraordinary occasion, resulting from the global
2 COVID-19 pandemic, caused a delay in the completion of the 2020
3 decennial census; and

4 WHEREAS, Due to the disruption caused by the COVID-19
5 pandemic, the United States Census Bureau did not release the 2020
6 Census Redistricting Data until August 2021, after the adjournment
7 of the 81st Session of the Nevada Legislature; and

8 WHEREAS, The Governor called the 33rd Special Session of the
9 Nevada Legislature on November 12, 2021, to consider matters of
10 redistricting and reapportionment; and

11 WHEREAS, The Secretary of the Senate Claire J. Clift, Assistant
12 Secretary of the Senate Sherry Rodriguez and a small number of the
13 able and dedicated staff of the Senate quickly prepared for this
14 special session; and

15 WHEREAS, Applying their incredible work ethic, proficiency
16 and ability to overcome obstacles, the Senate staff were able to meet
17 the demands of the special session to redistrict both legislative
18 houses, the congressional districts and the districts of the State
19 Board of Education and the Board of Regents of the University of
20 Nevada; and

2 professionally, regardless of the time of day or number of hours
3 required to ensure that legislative duties be completed in a timely
4 and efficient manner; now, therefore, be it
