## SENATE BILLS

### S.B. 1—Select Committee on Redistricting and Elections, Nov. 12.

Summary—Revises the election districts for members of the Legislature, members of the State Board of Education and Representatives in Congress and the petition districts for certain statewide initiatives or referendums. (BDR 17-9) Fiscal Note: Effect on Local Government: No. Effect on the State: Yes.

Nov. 12—Read first time. Referred to Select Committee on Redistricting and Elections. To printer.

Nov. 13—From printer. To committee. From committee: Do pass. Placed on Second Reading File. Read second time.

Nov. 14—Read third time. Passed. Title approved. (Yeas: 12, Nays: 9.) To Assembly. In Assembly. Read first time. Referred to Select Committee on Redistricting and Elections. To committee.

Nov. 15—From committee: Amend, and do pass as amended. Placed on Second Reading File. Read second time. Amended. (Amend. No. 2.) To printer.

Nov. 16—From printer. To engrossment. Engrossed. First reprint. Read third time. Passed, as amended. Title approved. (Yeas: 25, Nays: 17.) To Senate. In Senate. Assembly Amendment No. 2 concurred in. To enrollment. Enrolled and delivered to Governor. Approved by the Governor. Chapter 1.

**Sections 1 to 7, inclusive, and 22 effective January 1, 2022, for the purposes of filing for office and for nominating and electing members of the Nevada Legislature, and on November 9, 2022, for all other purposes. Sections 8 to 14, inclusive, and 23 effective November 16, 2021, for the purposes of creating each petition district within the State and for determining pursuant to the provisions of NRS 293.127563 the number of signatures required to be gathered from each petition district within the State for a petition for initiative or referendum that proposes a state constitutional amendment or other statewide ballot measure and, notwithstanding any other provisions of law, apply to each such petition that is filed with the Secretary of State pursuant to NRS 295.015: on or after November 16, 2021, or on or after August 1, 2021, and before November 16, 2021, if the petition is amended and the revised petition is filed with the Secretary of State on or after November 16, 2021; on November 16, 2021, for all purposes relating to the members of the State Board of Education; on January 1, 2022, for the purposes of filing for office and for nominating and electing Representatives in the Congress of the United States, and at 9:00 a.m. on January 3, 2023, for all other purposes. Sections 15 to 17, inclusive, effective January 1, 2022. Sections 18 to 21, inclusive, and 24 effective November 16, 2021.**
