THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

11	For each transfer of a registration of a representative to a	
12	different developer or location20	
13	For reinstatement of the registration of a representative 25	
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2. Each developer shall pay an additional fee for each membership he sells in a campground [containing] in which more than 50 [sites for camping memberships are available pursuant to the following schedule:

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Amount to be Number of [time shares] memberships paid per [site] membership

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  51—250$5.00
  251—500......4.00
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  501—750......3.00
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  751—1500......2.50
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- The administrator may reduce the fees established by this section if the reduction is equitable in relation to the costs of carrying out the provisions of this chapter.
