AN ACT relating to education; revising provisions governing patriotic observance in public schools; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE
AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 389.040 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 389.040 ~~[There shall be at least 1 hour set aside each school week in~~
3 ~~all graded schools and high schools in the State of Nevada for the purpose~~
4 ~~of holding patriotic exercises.]~~ ***Each public school shall set aside***
5 ***appropriate time at the beginning of each school day for pupils to pledge***
6 ***their allegiance to the flag of the United States. In addition, each public***
7 ***school may set aside appropriate time during the school day for***
8 ***additional patriotic observance.***
9 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 1999.
