AN ACT making an appropriation to the City of Las Vegas for programs for children after regularly scheduled school days; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND
ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
2 the City of Las Vegas the sum of \$2,500,000 for programs for children
3 after the regularly scheduled school day.
4 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
5 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and
6 reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money
7 committed have been made.
8 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
