SUMMARY—Prohibits certain persons from riding in certain portions of pickup truck.
(BDR 43-1350)

AN ACT relating to traffic laws; prohibiting certain persons from riding in the bed of a pickup truck or within a camper shell or slide-in camper; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE
AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 484.473 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 2 484.473 ***[A]***
- 3 ***1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, a person shall not ,***
- 4 ***with regard to a vehicle being operated on a paved highway, ride ~~on any~~***
- 5 ***~~vehicle~~ upon or within any portion ~~thereof~~ of the vehicle that is***
- 6 ***primarily designed or intended for carrying goods or other cargo or that***
- 7 ***is otherwise ~~not designed or intended for the use of passengers—This~~***
- 8 ***~~provision does not apply to an employee engaged in the necessary~~***
- 9 ***~~discharge of a duty, or to a person or persons riding within truck bodies~~***
- 10 ***~~and space intended for merchandise.] , including, without limitation,~~***
- 11 ***within the bed of a pickup truck or within a camper shell or slide-in***
- 12 ***camper.***
- 13 ***2. A person may ride within the bed of a pickup truck or within a***
- 14 ***camper shell or slide-in camper if the person is:***
- 15 ***(a) Sixteen years of age or older; or***
- 16 ***(b) Under 16 years of age and the pickup truck is not being operated***
- 17 ***on a freeway or in an urban area.***

- 1 3. *A citation must be issued to the driver of a vehicle in which a*
2 *person is riding in violation of this section. The driver shall be punished*
3 *by a fine of not more than \$25 or by a sentence to perform a certain*
4 *number of hours of work for the community.*
- 5 4. *A violation of this section:*
 - 6 (a) *Is not a moving traffic violation for the purposes of NRS 483.473;*
7 *and*
8 (b) *May not be considered:*
 - 9 (1) *Negligence in any civil action; or*
10 (2) *Negligence or reckless driving for the purposes of NRS 484.377.*
- 11 5. *As used in this section:*
 - 12 (a) *“Camper shell” has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 361.017.*
13 (b) *“Freeway” has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 408.060.*
14 (c) *“Slide-in camper” has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 482.113.*
- 15 **Sec. 2.** The amendatory provisions of this act do not apply to offenses
16 that are committed before October 1, 1999.
