THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** The registrar of voters of Clark County shall include on the

 - 1. The advisory question of whether the Floyd Lamb State Park in Las
- 4 Vegas, Nevada, should be renamed the Tule Springs State Park.
- 5 2. A statement that the passage or defeat of the advisory question
- 6 included on the ballot pursuant to subsection 1 is not binding upon:
- (a) Any local governing body in Clark County;

- (b) The Legislature of the State of Nevada; or
- 9 (c) Any member of the Legislature of the State of Nevada.
