AN ACT relating to hazardous materials; prohibiting the sale or use of certain highly flammable refrigerants; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** Chapter 459 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 1. A person shall not use, sell or offer to sell a product that is
- intended for use as a refrigerant for the air-conditioning system of a
- motor vehicle or a residential, commercial or industrial structure for a
- refrigerator or for a device used for cooling and heating unless the
- product complies with one of the following measures of flammability:
- (a) SAE J639 or SAE J1657 of the Society of Automotive Engineers;
- (b) ASHRAE Standard 34-1992 of the American Society of Heating,
- Refrigerating and Air Conditioning Engineers, Inc.;
 - (c) UL 2182 of the Underwriters Laboratories Inc.; or
- (d) ASTM E681-85 of the American Society for Testing and 12
- Materials. 13

- A person who violates the provisions of subsection 1 is guilty of a 14
- misdemeanor.

- Sec. 2. The amendatory provisions of this act do not apply to offenses that are committed before October 1, 1999.
