AN ACT relating to the practice of law; revising certain provisions relating to the unauthorized practice of law; increasing the penalties for the unlawful practice of law; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. NRS 7.285 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 7.285 1. [No] A person shall *not* practice law in this state [unless he is] if the person:
- (a) Is not an active member of the State Bar of Nevada or otherwise
- 5 *authorized to practice law in this state* pursuant to the rules of the supreme 6 court <del>[.</del>
- 7 2. Any person who, not being an active member of the State Bar of Nevada, or who, after hel; or
- 9 **(b)** Is suspended or has been disbarred [or while suspended] from membership in the State Bar of Nevada [, as provided in] pursuant to the rules of the supreme court. [, shall practice law,]
- 2. A person who violates any provision of subsection 1 is guilty of:
- 13 (a) For a first offense within the immediately preceding 7 years, a
- 14 misdemeanor.
- (b) For a second offense within the immediately preceding 7 years, a
- 16 gross misdemeanor.

- 1 (c) For a third and any subsequent offense within the immediately
  2 preceding 7 years, a category E felony and shall be punished as provided
  3 in NRS 193.130.
- 4 3. The State Bar of Nevada may bring a civil action to secure an injunction and any other appropriate relief against a person who violates this section.
- Sec. 2. The amendatory provisions of this act do not apply to offenses that are committed before October 1, 1999.
