AN ACT relating to prisoners; requiring a court to make certain deductions from a monetary judgment awarded to a prisoner in a civil action brought against the State of Nevada; requiring a prisoner who has filed an action for small claims to pay the estimated costs of his transportation to the department of prisons in advance; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY. DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** Chapter 176 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 3 1. If a defendant who is or was imprisoned in the state prison is
- 4 awarded a judgment for money against the State of Nevada, a
- 5 department, commission, board or other agency of the State of Nevada or
- 6 a current or former officer, employee or contractor of the State of Nevada
- 7 arising from a civil action that accrued while the defendant was
- 8 imprisoned in the state prison, the court shall make the following
- 9 deductions and send the money to the appropriate person, governmental
- 4 deductions and send the money to the appropriate person, governmental
- 10 agency or political subdivision of a governmental agency, in the following
- 11 order, from the money received from the judgment:
- 12 (a) An amount owed by the defendant for restitution;
- 13 (b) An amount owed by the defendant for an administrative
- 14 assessment;
- 15 (c) An amount owed by the defendant for a fine; and
- 16 (d) An amount owed by the defendant to repay the expenses of his
- 17 *defense*.

- 2. If any money remains after the court makes the deductions 2 pursuant to subsection 1, the court shall forward the remaining money to 3 the defendant.
- Sec. 2. Chapter 209 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 3, if an offender has filed an action for small claims pursuant to chapter 73 of NRS and the offender requests to appear as a witness in the action, he shall pay the 9 department in advance for the costs the department estimates will be incurred in providing transportation for the offender to appear in court.
- Within 30 days after providing transportation for an offender to 12 appear in court pursuant to subsection 1, the department shall:

- (a) Reimburse the offender for any amount paid by him that exceeds 13 14 the actual cost incurred by the department in providing transportation for 15 the offender; or
- (b) Charge the offender for any cost incurred by the department in 16 17 providing transportation for the offender that exceeds the amount paid by the defendant pursuant to subsection 1. 18
- The provisions of this section do not apply to indigent offenders. 19
