AN ACT relating to counties; providing in skeleton form for the revision of the date on which the term of office of a county commissioner commences; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE
AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 244.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 244.030 ~~{County commissioners shall enter upon their duties on the~~
3 ~~1st Monday of January succeeding their election, and, except for 2-year~~
4 ~~terms established pursuant to NRS 244.018, shall hold their offices for 4~~
5 ~~years as provided in this chapter; and the term of office shall expire at 12~~
6 ~~p.m. of the day preceding the 1st Monday in January following a general~~
7 ~~election.}~~ ***Except as otherwise provided in NRS 244.018, the term of***
8 ***office of a county commissioner is 4 years from the day next after his***
9 ***election.***

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
