AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Education for the Governor's Advisory Council on Education Relating to the Holocaust; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
2 the Department of Education the sum of \$75,000 for distribution to the
3 Governor's Advisory Council on Education Relating to the Holocaust
4 created pursuant to NRS 233G.020 for carrying out the duties of the
5 Council.

6 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
7 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and
8 reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money
9 committed have been made.

1 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
