AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Education for certain nonprofit public broadcasting stations that primarily serve educational, informational and cultural needs of communities in Nevada; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
- 2 the Department of Education the sum of \$300,000 for the support of
- 3 nonprofit public broadcasting stations in Nevada whose programs are
- 4 devoted primarily to serving the educational, informational and cultural
