

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 235—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

FEBRUARY 15, 1999

Referred to Committee on Ways and Means

SUMMARY—Directs Department of Personnel to increase salaries of certain positions in Department of Prisons and Department of Human Resources. (BDR S-1269)

AN ACT relating to public employment; directing the Department of Personnel to increase the salaries of certain custody positions in the Department of Prisons and Department of Human Resources; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND
ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. The Department of Personnel shall increase by two
2 grades the level of compensation of all custody positions within the
3 Department of Prisons and the Mental Hygiene and Mental Retardation
4 Division of the Department of Human Resources on the pay plan for
5 employees in the classified service of the state that is adopted pursuant to
6 NRS 284.175 and is effective on July 1, 1999.
7 2. As used in this section:
8 (a) “Custody position” includes, without limitation:
9 (1) Correctional officers and related supervisory positions;
10 (2) Correctional caseworkers and related supervisory positions; and
11 (3) Forensic specialists and related supervisory positions.
12 (b) “Grade” means the designation of a salary range for a classification
13 of employees.
14 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 1999.

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
