AN ACT relating to county government; increasing the number of members on the board of county commissioners in certain counties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** NRS 244.016 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 2 244.016 1. In each county whose population is 400,000 or more, the
- board of county commissioners consists of [seven] 13 members. Each
- 4 member must be a resident of, and elected by the registered voters of, a
- county commissioner election district established pursuant to this chapter.
- 6 2. The board of county commissioners shall establish [seven] 13
- 7 county commissioner election districts which must be as nearly equal in
 - population as practicable, and each of which must be composed entirely of
- 9 contiguous territory and be as compact as possible.
- Sec. 2. 1. On or before January 1, 2002, in any county whose
- population is 400,000 or more, the board of county commissioners shall,
- pursuant to NRS 244.018, establish new county commissioner election
- districts by ordinance and provide for the election of the new members
- added to the board pursuant to the amendatory provisions of section 1 of
- this act for initial terms of 2 years and 4 years so that the numbers of
- 16 county commissioners to be elected at each general election thereafter will
- 17 be as nearly equal as possible.

- 1 2. The new election districts established pursuant to subsection 1 for
- purposes of nominating candidates for and electing county commissioners
- at the general election in 2002 must be based on the population as
- 4 determined by the 2000 national decennial census conducted by the Bureau
- 5 of the Census of the United States Department of Commerce pursuant to
- 6 section 2 of article I of the Constitution of the United States and reported
- by the Secretary of Commerce to the governor pursuant to 13 U.S.C. § 141(c).
- Sec. 3. The provisions of subsection 1 of NRS 354.599 do not apply to any additional expenses of a local government that are related to the provisions of this act.
- Sec. 4. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2001, for the purposes of establishing the boundaries of the new county commissioner election
- 14 districts pursuant to the provisions of this act and for nominating
- 15 candidates for and electing county commissioners at the general election in
- 16 2002. For all other purposes, this act becomes effective on January 6,
- 17 2003.
