SUMMARY—Authorizes governing body of county to donate surplus personal property to nonprofit organization. (BDR 20-111)

AN ACT relating to counties; extending the authority to make charitable grants to include surplus personal property; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE
AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 244.1505 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 244.1505 1. A board of county commissioners may expend money
3 for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants
4 of the county. The board may grant all or part of the money to a private
5 organization, not for profit, to be expended for the selected purpose.
6 2. ***A board of county commissioners may donate personal property***
7 ***that is owned by the county but no longer needed to a private***
8 ***organization, not for profit, to be used for any purpose which will provide***
9 ***a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the county.***
10 3. A grant ***or donation*** to a private organization must be made by
11 resolution which must specify:
12 (a) The purpose of the grant ~~is~~ ***or donation;***
13 (b) The maximum amount to be expended from ~~the~~ ***a*** grant; and
14 (c) Any conditions or other limitations upon its expenditure ~~is~~ ***or use.***
15 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
