SUMMARY—Requires department of motor vehicles and public safety to report to legislature concerning tax on special fuel. (BDR 32-213)

AN ACT relating to the tax on special fuel; requiring the department of motor vehicles and public safety to prepare and submit a report to the legislature each odd-numbered year concerning the administration and enforcement of certain provisions relating to the tax on special fuel; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE
AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 366.110 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 366.110 The department:
3 1. Shall enforce the provisions of this chapter.
4 2. May adopt and enforce regulations relating to the administration and
5 enforcement of this chapter.
6 3. May determine whether any particular vehicle not specified in NRS
7 366.085 is special mobile equipment.
8 ***4. Shall, on or before March 1 of each odd-numbered year, prepare***
9 ***and submit a written report concerning the administration and***
10 ***enforcement of the provisions of this chapter during the immediately***
11 ***preceding biennium to the director of the legislative counsel bureau for***
12 ***transmittal to the next regular session of the legislature.***

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
