THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** NRS 201.261 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 2 201.261 "Nudity" means [the]:
- 3 1. The showing of the human female breast with less than a fully
- 4 opaque covering of any portion of the areola and nipple;
- 5 2. The showing of the human male or female genitals or pubic area
- 6 with less than a fully opaque covering of any portion thereof; or [the]
- 7 3. The depiction of [covered] the human male genitals in a discernible
- 8 turgid state $\begin{bmatrix} \cdot \end{bmatrix}$, whether or not covered.
- 9 Sec. 2. The amendatory provisions of this act do not apply to offenses
- that were committed before the effective date of this act.
- 11 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
