

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 30—COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION

PREFILED JANUARY 8, 1999

(ON BEHALF OF LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION’S STUDY OF THE
CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF HIGHWAYS)

Referred to Committee on Transportation

SUMMARY—Requires Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety to conduct study of costs incurred in administering programs for issuing certificates of registration for motor vehicles and drivers’ licenses. (BDR S-215)

AN ACT relating to the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety; requiring the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety to conduct a study to determine the costs incurred in administering the programs for issuing certificates of registration for motor vehicles and drivers’ licenses in this state; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND
ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** The Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety shall:
- 2 1. Conduct a study to determine whether the fees charged for:
- 3 (a) Certificates of registration for motor vehicles issued pursuant to
- 4 chapter 482 of NRS; and
- 5 (b) Drivers’ licenses issued pursuant to chapter 483 of NRS,
- 6 are equal to or greater than the costs the Department incurs in administering
- 7 the programs for the issuance of certificates of registration and drivers’
- 8 licenses; and

- 1 2. On or before February 15, 2001, submit a report of the study to the
- 2 Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmittal to the 71st
- 3 session of the Nevada Legislature.
- 4 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 1999.

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
