AN ACT making an appropriation to the revolving account for the management of estray horses in the Virginia Range; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
- 2 the revolving account for the management of estray horses in the Virginia
- 3 Range, created by section 2 of chapter 610, Statutes of Nevada 1997, at
- 4 page 3059, the sum of \$90,000 for feed, veterinary services and related
- 5 expenses of the program.
- 6 Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
- of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and
- reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money
- 9 committed have been made.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
