AN ACT relating to railroads; providing that no railroad train may operate in this state unless it has a crew of at least two competent employees; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY. DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** Chapter 705 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, no railroad train may be operated in this state unless the train has a crew of at least two competent employees. At least one of the employees on the crew must be a certified engineer.
 - 2. The public utilities commission of Nevada may grant an exception to subsection 1 if the commission determines that the exception will not endanger the life or property of any person.
- 3. The provisions of this section do not apply to the extent that they are contrary to or inconsistent with a regulation or order of the Federal Railroad Administration of the United States Department of
- 13 Transportation.
 - 4. As used in this section, "certified engineer" means a person
- 15 certified in accordance with Part 240 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal
- 16 Regulations as a train service engineer, locomotive servicing engineer or
- 17 student engineer.
