AN ACT making an appropriation to the legislative fund for expenditure by the Closeup Foundation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general
- 2 fund to the legislative fund, created pursuant to NRS 218.085, the sum of
- 3 \$10,000 for expenditure by the Closeup Foundation, an organization that
- 4 helps high school pupils attend the Nevada Legislature during the
- 5 legislative session.
- 6 2. Allocations from the appropriation made in subsection 1 must be
- 7 approved by the Legislative Commission upon its acceptance of a proposal

1 for the expenditure of money appropriated by subsection 1 by the Closeup
2 Foundation.

3 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
4 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and
5 reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money
6 committed have been made.

7 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 1999.

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
