AN ACT relating to damages; prohibiting a person from seeking noneconomic damages as a result of an accident involving a motor vehicle if the person owned or was operating or using the motor vehicle without insurance for the motor vehicle at the time of the accident; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY. DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Chapter 42 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 1. In an action to recover damages arising out of the operation or use of a motor vehicle, a person may not seek any noneconomic damages if the person:
- 6 (a) Was the owner, operator or user of a motor vehicle involved in the 7 accident giving rise to the action; and
- 8 (b) Did not have insurance for the motor vehicle at the time of the 9 accident.
- 10 2. As used in this section:
- (a) "Insurance" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 485.037.
- (b) "Motor vehicle" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 485.050.
- (c) "Noneconomic damages" means money awarded by the court to a
- 14 person for nonmonetary losses, including, without limitation, pain,

- 1 suffering, emotional distress, loss of consortium and injury to reputation,
- 2 or for the purpose of making an example of or punishing the person

- ordered to pay the damages.

 (d) "Operator" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 485.080.

 (e) "Owner" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 485.090.
