THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Chapter 484 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 1. A person shall not use a portable telephone, including, without limitation, a cellular phone, while operating a moving motor vehicle.
- 5 2. A person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a
- 6 misdemeanor.
- Sec. 2. The provisions of this act do not apply to offenses that were committed before October 1, 1999.
