## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** NRS 366.197 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 2 366.197 For the purpose of taxing the sale or use of compressed natural
- 3 gas, for liquefied petroleum gas, 125 cubic feet of natural gas for liquefied
- 4 petroleum gas] shall be deemed to equal 1 gallon of special fuel.
- 5 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 1999.
