Southern Nevada Writing Project and Northern Nevada Writing Project.

AN ACT making an appropriation to the University and Community College System of Nevada for
the Southern Nevada Writing Project and the Northern Nevada Writing Project; and
providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND
ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general
2 fund to the University and Community College System of Nevada for the
3 Southern Nevada Writing Project and the Northern Nevada Writing
4 Project:
5 For the fiscal year 1999-2000.....\$100,000
6 For the fiscal year 2000-2001.....\$100,000
7 2. The money appropriated by subsection 1 must be allocated equally
8 between the Southern Nevada Writing Project and the Northern Nevada
9 Writing Project for deposit in separate accounts for each project.
10 3. Disbursements from these accounts to pay the expenses of the
11 projects must be made by the Board of Regents of the University of Nevada
12 upon the request of the administrator of the respective project.

1 4. The sums appropriated by subsection 1 are available for either fiscal
2 year. Any balance of those sums must not be committed for expenditure
3 after June 30, 2001, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all
4 payments of money committed have been made.

5 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
