AN ACT relating to the care of children; creating and providing for the use of an account to improve the quality of services for child care; funding the account from the proceeds of certain rights to support assigned to the state; requiring a study to determine the results of the use of the account; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. NRS 425.430 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 2 425.430 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2 of this
- 3 section and in subsection 3 of NRS 425.410, any money recovered by the
- 4 enforcing authority under this chapter must be distributed pursuant to
- 5 regulations adopted by the division which must not disqualify this state for
- 6 federal grants under Title IV of the Social Security Act, [4] 42 U.S.C. §§
- 7 601 et seg. ().)
- 2. The money assigned to the division pursuant to NRS 425.350 that
- 9 is collected by the enforcing authority each fiscal year and retained as
- 10 reimbursement to the state for the provision of public assistance must,
- 11 *after deducting:*
- (a) Any payments required by federal law or as a condition to the
- 13 receipt of federal money; and

- (b) The administrative expenses of the state to carry out the program, be deposited in the account to improve the quality of services for child 3 care created pursuant to section 3 of this act.
- **Sec. 2.** Chapter 432A of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 3 and 4 of this act. 5
 - Sec. 3. 1. The account to improve the quality of services for child care is hereby created in the state general fund.
- The director shall administer the account and may accept gifts and grants of money from any source for deposit in the account. The director may expend not more than 50 percent of the amount deposited annually 11 in the account to carry out section 4 of this act.
- The interest and income earned on the money in the account, after 13 deducting any applicable charges, must be credited to the account. The money in the account does not lapse to the state general fund at the end of a fiscal year. All claims against the account must be paid as other claims against the state are paid.
 - Sec. 4. The director shall:

- 1. Establish a program to assist in:
- (a) Improving the education and training of providers of child care in 19 this state; 20
- (b) The certification of providers of child care in this state by the 21 National Association for the Education of Young Children or its successor organization;
 - (c) Increasing the ratio of the number of persons providing child care in this state to the number of children receiving child care in this state;
 - (d) Increasing the remuneration of providers of child care in this state; and
- (e) Decreasing the turnover rate among persons employed to provide 28 29 child care in this state.
- Prepare and advertise a request for proposals by independent 30 contractors to assist in carrying out the program established pursuant to 31 32 subsection 1. Any contract awarded to such a contractor must be awarded by competitive selection and require the contractor to provide 34 funding to carry out the program in an amount that is not less than the amount of money provided to the contractor by the director. 35
 - **Sec. 5.** The director of the department of human resources:
- Shall use his best efforts to ensure that the program established 37 pursuant to section 4 of this act is achieving successful results before January 1, 2001. 39
 - Shall:
 - (a) Cause an independent study to be conducted to determine:
- (1) The effect of the program established pursuant to section 4 of this 42 act on:

(I) The average amount of education and training obtained by providers of child care in this state;

- (II) The number of providers of child care in this state who have obtained or are in the process of obtaining certification from the National Association for the Education of Young Children or its successor organization;
- (III) The ratio of the number of persons providing child care in this state to the number of children receiving child care in this state;
- (IV) The average amount of remuneration received by providers of child care in this state; and
- (V) The turnover rate among persons employed to provide child care in this state; and
- (2) The amount, origin and purpose of funding provided to carry out the program established pursuant to section 4 of this act, from sources other than the account to improve the quality of services for child care created pursuant to section 3 of this act; and
- (b) On or before January 15, 2001, submit the findings of the study to the director of the legislative counsel bureau for transmittal to the 71st session of the Nevada Legislature.
- 3. May expend money from the account to improve the quality of services for child care created pursuant to section 3 of this act to carry out the provisions of subsection 2.
- **Sec. 6.** This act becomes effective on June 30, 1999.
