AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Education for programs, personnel and educational services for American Indian children and culturally diverse children; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY. DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general
- fund to the Department of Education for programs, personnel and
- 3 educational services designed to meet the special educational needs of
- 4 American Indian children and culturally diverse children, including
- 5 children whose native language is not English:
- 6 For the fiscal year 1999-2000.....\$148,989
- 7 For the fiscal year 2000-2001.....\$171,120
- 8 2. The money appropriated pursuant to subsection 1 must be used by
- 9 the Department of Education to employ one educational consultant to serve
- the special needs of American Indian children, one educational consultant

- to serve the special needs of culturally diverse children, including children whose native language is not English, and one part-time secretary, and for travel, equipment and operational expenses related thereto.
- Sec. 2. Any balance of the sums appropriated by section 1 of this act remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must not be committed for expenditure after June 30 of the respective fiscal years and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.
- Sec. 3. The Department of Education shall evaluate the programs for
 American Indian children and culturally diverse children, including
 children whose native language is not English, that are funded by the
 appropriation made pursuant to section 1 of this act and report its findings
 to the 71st session of the Nevada Legislature on or before March 15, 2001.
 The report must include an evaluation of the effect such programs have
 had on meeting the special needs of such children and increasing the
 participation of such children in school programs that assist them in
- achieving high educational standards.

 Sec. 4. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
