AN ACT making an appropriation to the State Public Works Board for a feasibility study regarding the construction of a Hi-Tech Learning Center in Lyon County, Nevada; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general
- 2 fund to the State Public Works Board the sum of \$150,000 for a feasibility
- study regarding the construction of a Hi-Tech Learning Center in Lyon
- 4 County at Yerington High School or Fernley High School.
- 2. On or before March 1, 2001, the State Public Works Board shall
- 6 report the results of its study to the Director of the Legislative Counsel
- 7 Bureau for transmittal to the 71st session of the Nevada Legislature.
- 8 Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
- 9 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and
- reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money
- 11 committed have been made.
- Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
