SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to State Public Works Board for feasibility study regarding construction of Hi-Tech Learning Center in Lyon County, Nevada. (BDR S-949)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the State Public Works Board for a feasibility study regarding the construction of a Hi-Tech Learning Center in Lyon County, Nevada; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND
ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general
2 fund to the State Public Works Board the sum of \$150,000 for a feasibility
3 study regarding the construction of a Hi-Tech Learning Center in Lyon
4 County at Yerington High School or Fernley High School.
5 2. On or before March 1, 2001, the State Public Works Board shall
6 report the results of its study to the Director of the Legislative Counsel
7 Bureau for transmittal to the 71st session of the Nevada Legislature.
8 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
9 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and
10 reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money
11 committed have been made.
12 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
