AN ACT making an appropriation to the State Public Works Board for feasibility studies regarding the construction of Hi-Tech Learning Centers in Lyon County and in Douglas County, Nevada; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general
- fund to the State Public Works Board the sum of \$150,000 for two
- 3 feasibility studies regarding the construction of Hi-Tech Learning Centers in:
- 5 (a) Lyon County at Yerington High School or Fernley High School; and
- (b) Douglas County.
- 2. On or before March 1, 2001, the State Public Works Board shall
- 8 report the results of its studies to the Director of the Legislative Counsel
- 9 Bureau for transmittal to the 71st session of the Nevada Legislature.
- Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
- of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and
- 12 reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money
- 13 committed have been made.
- 14 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
