SUMMARY—Makes contingent appropriation to Department of Transportation for construction of extension to sound barrier on east side of U.S. Highway No. 95/Interstate Highway No. 515 near Elaina Avenue in Las Vegas. (BDR S-478)

AN ACT making a contingent appropriation to the Department of Transportation for the construction of an extension to the sound barrier along the east side of U.S. Highway No. 95/Interstate Highway No. 515 near Elaina Avenue in Las Vegas; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND
ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
2 the Department of Transportation the sum of \$748,500 for the construction
3 of a 5,000-foot extension to the sound barrier along the east side of U.S.
4 Highway No. 95/Interstate Highway No. 515 continuing from the south end
5 of the existing sound barrier and terminating near the end of Nellis
6 Boulevard near Elaina Avenue in Las Vegas.
- 7 **Sec. 2.** The Department of Transportation may use the money
8 appropriated pursuant to section 1 of this act only if matching money is
9 received in full from local governments or other public or private sources.
- 10 **Sec. 3.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
11 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after the project is
12 completed and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of
13 money committed have been made.

1 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
