AN ACT relating to district courts; providing for an additional judge for the fifth judicial district; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE
AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 3.015 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 3.015 For the fifth judicial district there must be ~~one district judge.~~
3 ***two district judges.***
4 **Sec. 2.** The additional district judge required for the fifth judicial
5 district pursuant to section 1 of this act must be appointed by the governor
6 and serve until January 1, 2001. The successor of this judge must be
7 selected at the general election to be held on November 7, 2000, and take
8 office on January 1, 2001. The term of the successor judge expires on
9 January 6, 2003.
10 **Sec. 3.** The provisions of subsection 1 of NRS 354.599 do not apply to
11 any additional expenses of a local government that are related to the
12 provisions of this act.
13 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
