## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. NRS 3.015 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 2 3.015 For the fifth judicial district there must be [one district judge.]
- 3 two district judges.
- 4 **Sec. 2.** The additional district judge required for the fifth judicial
- 5 district pursuant to section 1 of this act must be appointed by the governor
- 6 and serve until January 1, 2001. The successor of this judge must be
- 7 selected at the general election to be held on November 7, 2000, and take
- 8 office on January 1, 2001. The term of the successor judge expires on
- 9 January 6, 2003.
- Sec. 3. The provisions of subsection 1 of NRS 354.599 do not apply to
- any additional expenses of a local government that are related to the
- 12 provisions of this act.
- Sec. 4. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
