AN ACT relating to mobile home parks; prohibiting a landlord of a mobile home park from prohibiting a tenant from exhibiting a political sign within the boundary of the lot of the tenant; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Chapter 118B of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 1. A landlord or an agent or employee of a landlord shall not prohibit a tenant from exhibiting a political sign within the boundary of the lot of the tenant.
- 6 2. As used in this section, "political sign" means a sign, display or device that:
- 8 (a) Expresses support for or opposition to a candidate, political party 9 or ballot question; or
- 10 (b) Otherwise relates to a political campaign or election.
