THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
- the Department of Transportation the sum of \$253,290 for the construction
- of a sound barrier along the ramps of Interstate Highway No. 515 near the

- Sec. 2. The Department of Transportation may use the money

- of this act must not be committed for expenditure after the project is
