SUMMARY—Increases amount of longevity payments to state employees. (BDR 23-1285)

AN ACT relating to state employees; increasing the amount of longevity payments to state employees; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE
AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 284.177 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 284.177 1. A plan to encourage continuity of service, administered
3 by the department is hereby established for employees with 8 years or
4 more of continuous state service. ~~Employees~~ ***Except as otherwise***
5 ***provided in NRS 284.179, an employee*** rated standard or better with 8
6 years of continuous service ~~are~~ ***is*** entitled to receive \$75 semiannually
7 with a semiannual increase of :
8 ***(a) For employees with 9 through 16 years of continuous service, \$25***
9 ***for each additional year of service ;***
10 ***(b) For employees with 17 through 23 years of continuous service, \$50***
11 ***for each additional year of service; and***
12 ***(c) For employees with 24 or more years of continuous service, \$75***
13 ***for each additional year of service*** up to a maximum of 30 years of
14 continuous state service.
15 2. An interruption in continuous state service terminates the
16 employee's eligibility for additional pay pursuant to subsection 1.

1 3. Except as provided in this subsection, no year served before the
2 interruption may be counted in determining the employee's subsequent
3 eligibility. This provision does not apply to an employee who was
4 employed before July 1, 1981, unless he leaves state service after that date.

5 4. As used in this section, "continuous service" means uninterrupted
6 service as defined by the commission.

7 **Sec. 2.** The amendatory provisions of this act apply only to
8 calculations made for payments on or after July 1, 1999.

9 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 1999.

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
