SUMMARY—Provides prospectively for legal counsel for board of regents of University of Nevada from office of attorney general. (BDR 34-1227)

AN ACT relating to the board of regents of the University of Nevada; providing prospectively for legal counsel for the board of regents from the office of the attorney general; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE
AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** Chapter 396 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto
2 a new section to read as follows:
3 *The attorney general is the counsel and attorney for the board of*
4 *regents. The attorney general shall designate one of his deputies to be*
5 *counsel and attorney for the board of regents in all actions, proceedings*
6 *and hearings. The deputy so designated:*
7 1. *Is the legal adviser of the board of regents in all matters relating*
8 *to the board of regents and to the powers and duties of its members.*
9 2. *Shall maintain his office in Carson City, Nevada, in an office*
10 *provided by the board of regents.*
11 3. *Is in the unclassified service of the state pursuant to subsection 5*
12 *of NRS 284.140.*
13 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2001.

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
