AN ACT relating to hunting; prohibiting a person who has received a refund for a hunting license from being denied bonus points for additional chances to obtain a hunting tag; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** Chapter 502 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 1. No person who has requested and received a refund for the value
- 4 of his hunting license, less any nonrefundable administrative fee adopted 5 by the commission for acting upon an application for a tag, may be
- 6 denied participation in or the award of any bonus points that may be
- 7 accumulated by him through a program for the receipt of bonus points
- 8 solely because he received such a refund.
- 9 2. As used in this section, "program for the receipt of bonus points"
- 10 means a program established by the commission and administered by the
- 11 division whereby a person who is unsuccessful in applying for a resident 12 tag:

- (a) Is awarded a bonus point or other numerical indicator that entitles
  the person to receive an additional number for use in a subsequent
  drawing for a resident tag; or
  (b) Receives a subsequent opportunity to apply for or participate in a
  drawing for a resident tag.
