AN ACT relating to gaming; revising the provisions governing the location of gaming establishments in residential neighborhoods; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY. DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 20 of chapter 452, Statutes of Nevada 1997, at 1 page 1713, is hereby amended to read as follows: Sec. 20. 1. A proposed resort hotel: 3 (a) That is located on 25 or more acres of property; 4 (b) That is located in the unincorporated area of the county, 5 which has been designated for gaming by the master plan of the 6 county; and 7 [3.] (c) For which an application for appropriate zoning is 8 submitted to the county before June 28, 1997, 9 may petition the county, city or town having jurisdiction over the 10 location of the proposed establishment to designate the location of 11 12 the proposed establishment a gaming enterprise district pursuant to NRS [463.194.] 463.3084. 13 2. A proposed resort hotel: 14 (a) That is located on 15 or more contiguous acres of property; 15 (b) That is located within 500 feet from the centerline of a state 16 highway that does not intersect the Las Vegas Boulevard gaming 17 corridor and along which at least three licensed resort hotels are 18 effective located the date 19 on act; and (c) That is located within 500 feet from a parcel of land on which a licensed resort hotel is located on the effective date of this act,

may petition the county, city or town having jurisdiction over the location of the proposed establishment to designate the location of the proposed establishment a gaming enterprise district pursuant to NRS 463.3084.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
