AN ACT relating to veteran affairs; broadening permissible locations to hold meetings of the Nevada veterans' services commission; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** NRS 417.170 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 2 417.170 1. The Nevada veterans' services commission shall meet at
- 3 least four times and not more than six times every fiscal year.
- 2. Meetings of the veterans' services commission may be held at the
- 5 call of the chairman whenever he determines that there is sufficient
- 6 business to warrant action by the veterans' services commission or
- 7 whenever five members of the veterans' services commission submit a
- 8 written request for a meeting.
- Meetings of the veterans' services commission must alternate
- between the city in which the office of the executive director is located and
- 11 Las Vegas , unless the chairman designates a different location for a
- 12 meeting.

- 1 4. Notice of the time, place and purpose of all meetings must be given 2 in writing to each member at least 5 days before the meeting.
