AN ACT relating to veteran affairs; authorizing the Nevada veterans' services commission to hold additional meetings; expanding the permissible locations at which meetings of the commission may be held; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** NRS 417.170 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 2 417.170 1. The Nevada veterans' services commission shall meet at
- 3 least four times and not more than [six] eight times every fiscal year.
- 2. Meetings of the veterans' services commission may be held at the
- 5 call of the chairman whenever he determines that there is sufficient
- 6 business to warrant action by the veterans' services commission or
- 7 whenever five members of the veterans' services commission submit a
- 8 written request for a meeting.
 - 3. Meetings of the veterans' services commission must falternate
- 10 between the city in which the office of the executive director is located and
- 11 be held:
- 12 (a) In Las Vegas $[\cdot, \cdot]$;
- 13 **(b)** *In Reno*; *or*
- 14 (c) At any other location if conducted by teleconference.

- 1 4. Notice of the time, place and purpose of all meetings must be given 2 in writing to each member at least 5 days before the meeting.
