AN ACT relating to mortgage companies; requiring mortgage companies to disclose certain costs to buyers and sellers of real property; authorizing a seller to rescind contract in certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY. DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Chapter 645B of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 3 1. Within 24 hours after an agreement for the purchase of real
- 4 property is entered into or within 24 hours after the mortgage company
- 5 notifies the buyer or seller that the mortgage company will loan money
- 6 that is secured by a lien on the real property to the buyer, whichever
- 7 occurs later, a mortgage company must provide to the buyer and seller of
- 8 the real property a dated written statement signed by a representative of
- 9 the mortgage company that lists separately each cost the seller is required
- to pay with respect to the loan of the buyer and the manner in which any
- 11 payment will be applied.
- 12 2. If the seller does not agree to pay the costs set forth in the
- 13 statement provided pursuant to subsection 1, the seller may rescind any
- 14 agreement for the purchase of the real property within 24 hours after
- 15 receiving the statement without any penalties.

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
