AN ACT relating to school personnel; removing the requirement that a superintendent of schools of a school district be licensed as a school administrator; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE
AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 391.110 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 391.110 1. The board of trustees of a school district may:
3 (a) Employ any person ~~licensed for the position of administrator~~ ***whom***
4 ***the board of trustees determines is qualified*** to serve as the superintendent
5 of schools of the school district. The commission may require the
6 superintendent of any school district to hold a master's degree.
7 (b) Define his powers and fix his duties.
8 (c) Fix his salary.
9 2. ***If the board of trustees of a school district employs a person who is***
10 ***not licensed as an administrator to serve as the superintendent of***
11 ***schools, the board of trustees shall employ a person who is licensed as an***
12 ***administrator to oversee the academic programs of the public schools***
13 ***within the school district.***
14 3. A superintendent of schools may be employed for an initial term not
15 to exceed 4 years. The term of any subsequent employment may be of any
16 duration.
17 ~~13.1~~ 4. A superintendent of schools may be dismissed at any time for
18 cause.

- 2 affirmations relating to public schools.
- 3 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 1999.

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
