AN ACT relating to state financial administration; authorizing the supreme court of Nevada to enter into a long-term lease for office space for the court in Clark County which extends beyond the 1999-2001 biennium; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of NRS 353.260, the
- supreme court of Nevada may enter into a contract for a 20-year lease of
- 3 office space for the court in Clark County which extends in duration
- 4 beyond the 1999-2001 biennium and thereby constitutes a debt of the State
- 5 of Nevada except that the total amount of money committed over the 20-
- 6 year period may not exceed \$8,928,000, exclusive of operation and
- 7 maintenance costs. Money for the payment of the debt incurred pursuant to
- 8 this section will be provided for in the annual tax imposed for the payment
- 9 of the obligations of the State of Nevada from the consolidated bond
- interest and redemption fund or by other legislative act. The provisions of
- NRS 349.238 to 349.248, inclusive, apply to payment of the debt. The
- interest, if any, on the debt generated by the 20-year lease must be paid at
- least semiannually and the principal must be paid within 20 years after the
- 14 date of passage of this act.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
